

P-SC-01: Everthorpe Village, Ferry Beck and West End, South Cave

Ferry Beck drains a wide area north of South Cave, including Everthorpe, and becomes constrained by the residential area of West End, South Cave.

The distinct catchment of South Cave Beck drains the from Wolds to the east, and is subject to a proposal by ERYC Flood Risk for a Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), to the east of the village. Both Becks converge south of the A63.

The agricultural drains of Ferry Beck could be subject to a number of NFM measures, the most obvious being leaky dams. There are also a number of culverts which have the potential to be day-lighted to increase capacity and biodiversity.

Part of the area, 'Watery Plump' is a local nature reserve. It would be essential that proposals would enhance and not damage the characteristics which define this LNR

South Cave Parish Council has expressed an interest in being involved with any proposals for the Ferry Beck area.
